




Kenya Luxury Honeymoon

Bush Rovers Tanzania

Your game drives are conducted in a separate 4x4 game vehicle. A truly different experience to get close to nature without compromising on comfort!

Day 1

Day 2

Met on arrival at Mwanza and transfer to Little Okavango Camp on the shores of Lake Victoria. Afternoon canoe safari through Lake Victoria narrow water channels, dwarfed by tall papyrus grasses and surrounded by stunning birdlife. Dinner and overnight.

Day 3

Transfer to the Bush Rover Migration Camp, isolated, yet in the heart of the action, whether in the Western Corridor set by the Grumeti River or by the Mara River at a wildebeest crossing point. Full board in the Bush Rover Migration Camp.









Days 4–5

Day 1

Fly from the UK to Cape Town.

Days 2–4 Cape Town

Met on arrival by our local representative and transferred to your hotel for 3 nights at the Inn on the Square or similar.

Plenty do in and around Cape Town at your own pace.

FREE: Cape Town City Sightseeing Bus Ticket included. Each guided bus tour includes insightful commentary about the city, its history and its culture. Tours start and end at the V&A Waterfront.

Days 5–6 Plettenberg Bay (Garden Route)

Collect your hire car and depart on the scenic garden route – the most popular in South Africa! Covering a great part of the southwestern coast of South Africa, the Garden Route stretches from Mossel Bay to the Tsitsikamma Forest and Storms River. The Garden Route is a coastal corridor along the N2 highway, where ancient forests, rivers, wetlands, dunes, stretches of beach, lakes, mountain scenery and indigenous fynbos all merge to form a landscape of splendid beauty. By late afternoon arrive at the pretty beach village of Plettenberg Bay. Spend 2 nights here, exploring the surroundings. Overnight at Redbourne Country Lodge or similar.

Day 7 Cape St Francis

Days 10-11 Oudtshoorn

Depart through the Great Karoo back to Western Cape Province. Afternoon arrive at Oudtshoorn, known as the ostrich capital of the world and situated in the Klein Karoo between Swartberg and Outeniqua Mountains. Spend 2 nights at Mooiplaas Guest House or similar.

Days 12-13 Stellenbosch

Route 62 is modelled on the iconic US Route 66 and is one of the most beautiful routes in South Africa; running through the vineyards. FREE: Stone Town Tour included for minimum 7-night stay in Zanzibar

The tour begins with a visit to Zanzibar's colourful market, alive with the buzz of locals bartering for fresh vegetables and tropical fruit. Continue to the site of a cathedral built in 1874. The cathedral signifies a potent time in Zanzibar's history and stands on the sight of a past slave market with the high altar standing on the exact site of the whipping post. Slavery was abolished in 1873 by decree of the Sultan of Zanzibar. From here visit the residence of the late Sultan of Zanzibar, 'Tip Tip House', the Old Fort, 'Peoples Palace' and the House of Wonders', full of intrigue from days of long ago. The tour ends with a stroll down the narrow streets of old Stone Town, the heart of Zanzibar's chequered history.
